This month, *Archives of Facial Plastic Surgery* and *Archives of Dermatology* publish a joint theme issue on facial rejuvenation. *Archives of Dermatology* topics include carbon dioxide laser to resurface sun-damaged skin; single-pass carbon dioxide laser skin resurfacing with cold-air cooling; Q-switched Nd:YAG laser to treat atrophic acne scars; flashlamp pulsed-dye laser treatment of rosacea; diffusion of botulinum exotoxin A; evaluating core procedural skills; facial remodeling; safety of office-based surgery; and rejuvenation of the aging face.
